5th and 6th Streets Project Update

- Chief has been authorized by council to prepare and submit the grant application for a water main replacement and repaving project.
- On November 20th, 2025, The Village of Waynesville was awarded a grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC PY40 FY2026).
- Total cost of the project is \$1,651,500. Grant will cover \$1,139,540.00. Village will be funding \$511,960.00. Warren County will provide \$98,110.00. Warren County will also line the sanitary sewer lines.

Well #10

- The wellhead and pitless adapter have been installed. The pump and lateral line will be installed in mid-December, followed by an EPA pump test.

SR 42 and North Street traffic light project update.

- Strain pole footers have been poured, and poles have been ordered.
- The project is expected to be completed in late spring or early summer of 2026

Demolition of the house at 88 S. Third Street has begun. Street closures will occur at various times throughout the process.

The Water Department replaced a hydrant at 1050 Rose Petal Court.

There is a meeting scheduled for December 9th at 10am with Greg Hennecke, the Villages Ohio Plan Risk Management Representative. He will review the Villages property(s) and fleet to identify any potential liabilities. Recommendations will come at a later date.
