

## Public Works Meeting February 2<sup>nd</sup> 2026

- \*Meeting started at 6:00 P.M.
  - \*Committee members present were Zack Gallagher, Troy Lauffer, and Adam Powell
  - \*Staff Present were Chief Copeland and Jamie Morley

  - \*Motion to approve the previous minutes were passed by Mr. Lauffer and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Gallagher
  - \*A motion to approve Mr. Gallagher to the chair was made by Mr. Lauffer and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Gallagher
  - \*Chief Copeland opened the meeting by discussing that many projects are put on hold due to the abnormal weather conditions. Chief Copeland went over the purchase of the Skid loader, and the ordinance will be presented at tonight's Council meeting.
  - \*Chief Copeland further advised that there will be an ordinance for next year's Bid on Salt. Chief Copeland continued with explaining that we had a water break on Robindale, and that he wanted to have a third party company come in and fix it, but our guys wanted to handle the task themselves and completed the break without outside help. Chief wanted to commend them for doing so.
  - \*Lemay Property was discussed, that Addison Properties is wanting to build 350 homes, and will be discussed in the future.
  - \*Chief Copeland then asked questions about a merger with Corwin. Chief said there are about 480 homes that would be involved. Mr. Gallagher and Mrs. Morley asked if we could get record data. Mrs. Miller said we need to act now because it could take a few years.
